Year in Review

The SWC began the 2022 season with a return to in-person rehearsals.

The SWC Board of Directors continued using Zoom for regular and special meetings due to the benefits of savings travel time, gas, and expense for meeting rooms.

On March 22, 2022, Carol Paskulin, President, and Robin Richie, Artistic Director of SWC were interviewed by Laureen Fallahay on Live Wire which airs on Access Sacramento. Access Sacramento is a local, non-profit television station. A leadership workshop was held on May 14, 2022. Eve Campbell from GALA facilitated the workshop to help SWC formulate strategic goals and next steps for the chorus.

The SWC held a bi-annual meeting on June 25 and heard a presentation from the Belongings Committee. Other topics heard were the chorus structure, chorus financials, and plans for the future of the chorus.

In July 2022, Kristen Hollon Miller, chorus member, volunteered to create an oral history for the chorus. This history can help build a shared identity, expand local and national profile, and aid in fundraising efforts.

In October 2022, a grant in the amount of \$25,000 was awarded to SWC for the purpose of hiring a Fundraising Manager to perform the duties of fund raising, grant writing, creating, and maintaining a donor list, and some marketing.

The SWC Annual Meeting was held on November 5, 2022, to elect new Board members for the 2023 season.

Concerts In Our Community

On April 30, 2022, the SWC performed its Spring Concert that was entitled "Always a Place for You." It was followed on May 7th by performing with the Sacramento Valley Concert Choir.

Performed at the Sacramento Pride Festival on June 11 and the Davis Pride Festivals on June 12.

On July 30, 2022, SWC performed at the California State Fair on "Out at the Fair" day.

A concert was held on October 20, 2022, to celebrate 35 years of the existence of the SWC. The title of the event was "We're Still Here."

The end the 2022 season, SWC held a holiday concern titled "Merry Everything" at St. Marks United Methodist Church and the California State Capitol rotunda.
